Cancellation/Refund Policy : A full refund (minus a \$35 processing fee) will be given when the request for a refund is made up to 30 days prior to the first day of a workshop. Refunds are not available for cancellations less than 30 days before a workshop. However, paid registrants can transfer to another workshop within one year at no additional cost. Refunds are not available after a transfer is made or if you do not provide advanced notice that you will not be attending the workshop. For all other items or events, the processing fee will be 10% of the purchase price or a minimum of \$5.

Positive Discipline Focuses on Discipline that:

- Helps the children feel a sense of connection (Belonging and Significance).
- Is effective in the long-term, considering what the child is thinking, feeling, and deciding.
- Teaches important social and life skills (respect, concern for others, problem solving and cooperation as well as the skills to contribute to the home, school or larger community).

Participants in the workshop will:

- Learn evidence based effective tools and approaches for teaching parents how to use discipline that is kind and firm at the same time (non-punitive, non-permissive).
- Learn how to facilitate parenting classes from the position of a non-expert with reference materials and additional resources.
- Gain practice with experiential exercises that help parents go beyond intellectual understanding to be able to respond in empowering ways with their children.
- Have materials for group settings, parenting classes and home visits with families.
