

# POSITIVE DISCIPLINE IN THE CLASSROOM



This interactive 6 session workshop is designed for *teachers, counselors, school staff* and *administrators* who want an effective discipline approach that integrates social and emotional learning (SEL) while reducing challenging student behaviors in classrooms and on campus. The use of experiential activities allow participants to practice what they learn and deepen their understanding. This workshop provides professional development for educators to use Positive Discipline, an Adlerian based philosophy, in their school or classroom setting.

## Participants will learn to:

- Develop a large teaching toolbox of kind and firm discipline approaches.
- Establish explicit classroom structures and procedures.
- Create an equitable classroom community based on mutual respect.
- Understand the motivation behind the students' misbehavior and how to encourage positive change.
- Facilitate effective class meetings teaching social skills and problem-solving.
- Learn Positive Discipline/Adlerian Psychology for use in the classroom and school community.
- Generate an awareness of cross-cultural issues in facilitating social and emotional learning.
